Individuals at this level have advanced leadership skills and are in charge of a team of warehouse workers, arranging workflow, monitoring stock levels, and providing reports to management. They facilitate conflict resolutions within their team and help facilitate and maintain a safe and OH&S compliant workplace.

Course delivery & structure:
