Certification & Licensing

To get a forklift license in Tasmania, you must:

1. Complete a recognised training course with a registered training organisation (RTO).
2. Obtain an interim High Risk Forklift Licence.
3. Lodge your licence application at a Service Tasmania outlet within 60 days.
4. Pay the prescribed fee and have your photograph taken.

Learning Outcomes

Upon successful completion of the course, you will be able to:

- ✓ **Plan the Work or Task:** Assess equipment suitability, identify hazards, and ensure safety requirements are met.
- ✓ **Perform the Task:** Safely lift, transport, and position loads.
- ✓ **Pack Up:** Shut down and secure the forklift according to workplace and regulatory standards.
