# **Certificate IV in Supply Chain Operations**

#### **Overview**

The recently created Certificate IV in Supply Chain Operations is designed to combine Warehousing Operations and Logistics qualifications from the previous package and includes an optional specialisation in multiple streams.

Individuals at this level might be expected to evaluate, analyse, and develop new procedures, and provide leadership and guidance to others in skill development and application of skills to their work.

It is generally a requirement for Traineeships that a candidate be in a supervisory or scheduling role.

#### **Delivery and Structure**

Delivery underpins our philosophy that work is the learning and learning is the work. We deliver a combination of formal training sessions and mentoring. We utilise a mix of on-the-job observation and questioning, and workplace-based projects throughout our assessment tasks.

Participants are encouraged to challenge their existing knowledge and extend their boundaries whilst they expand their skill base.


